Whereas the settler is desirous of establishing a trust for public charitable objects.

And Whereas the trustees have at the request of the settler agreed to act as the first trustees of these presents as testified by their being parties to and executing these presents and whereas it is necessary to declare the objects and terms of the public charitable trust being constituted under these presents.

Now this indenture witnesseth as follows:


1. That in the order to effectuate his aforesaid desire, the settler has set apart and handed over to the trustees, a sum of Rs. 50,501,00 (Fifty thousand five hundred one only) (hereinafter called the "Trust Fund" which expression shall include cash and any other property or investments of any kind whatsoever into which the same or any part there of might be converted, invested or varied from time to time of which may be acquired by the trustees or may come to their hands by virtue of these presents or by operation of law or otherwise wahtsoever in relation to these presents) and trustees shall hold and stand possessed of the same upon the trust subject to the powers, provisions, agreements and declarations hereinafter contained.

(c) To establish, maintain and run studentships, scholarships and render other kind of aid to students including supply of books, stipents, medals and other incentives to study, without any distinction as to caste, colour race, creed or sex.

(d) To promote, establish, support, maintain or grant aid to institutions for the promotion of science, literature, music, drama and fine arts, for the preservation of historical monuments and for the research and other benefit of the public in general.

That the name of trust shall be Dr. R. N. Singh Memorial Trust Chapra (Estd.) 2007). and its office shall be for the present be situated at Katra Chapra and I or such other place or places as the Trustees may decide from time to time.

3. That the objects for which this trust is established are :

(a) To establish, run, support and grant aid or other financial assistance to schools, colleges, libraries, reading rooms, universities, laboratories, research centres and other Institutions of the like nature in India, for use of the students and the staff and also for developement and advancement of education and difffusion of knowldege amongst the public in general.

(b) To establish, develope, maintain and grant aid in cash or in kind to hospitals medical schools, medical colleges, Pairamedical institutions, nursing institutions, dispensaries, maternity homes, child welfare centers and/ or such other similar charitable institutions in India for the benefit and use of the general

(c) To establish, maintain and run studentships, scholarships and render other kind of aid to students including supply of books, stipends, medals and other incentives to study, without any distinction as to caste, colour, race, creed or

(d) To promote, establish, support, maintain or grant aid to institutions for the promotion of science, literature, music, drama and fine arts, for the preservation of historical monuments and for the reasearch and other institutions, in India, having similar objects for the benefit of the public in general.


(e) To eatablish, maintain or grant aid for the establishment and maintenance of parks, gardens, gymnasiums, sports clubs, dharamshalas and rest houses, for use by public in general.

(f) To establish, maintain or grant aid to homes for the old aged persons' orphans or others

Establishments for the relief and help to the poor, needy and destitute people. orphans, widows and old aged persons

(g) To establish and develop institutions, for the physically handicapped and disabled or mentally retarded persons and to provide them education, food, clothing or other help.





(i) To construct, repair and manage the marghats, cemeteris and burial grounds.
(i) To rant aid or render assistance to other public charitable trust or institu-

tions.

(4) That the Trust Fund may be amalgamated by the income from the initial fund and also by donations and other contributions from time to time.

(5) That the Trust fund shall not be applied for any purpose other than those specified in para 3 hereinabove.

(6) That the Trustees shall always maintain proper accounts of the Trust , which shall be kept at the office of the trust .

(7) That for the furtherance of the objects of the trust, the trustees shall have the following powers:

(a) To accept any donation, contribution, grant or subscription in cash or in kind, From any person (s), body of persons or trust, with or without conditins.

(b) To apply the whole or any part of the income of the trust, or ther trust fund or accumulations thereto, any one or more of the objects of the trust, as the trustees may in their descretion deem fit from time to time,

(c) To convert and deal with the trust property and or any investmets

for the time being

- (d) To invest the Trust Fund either in the purpose of mortgage immovable property or in shares, stocks or debentures or other securities and investments, or in deposits with or loans to any company, bank, firm or any other person, and to alter, vary or transpose such investments, from time at the discretion of the trustees.
- (e) To borrow or raise or secure payments of moneys and also to lend money either with or without securities.

(f) to sell, dispose of alienate or otherwise deal with any property comprising the Trust Fund.

(g) To let out, demise any immovable property comprised in the Trust Fund for such period and at such rent on such terms and conditions as the trustees in their discretion may think fit.

(h) To open account in the name of Trust, trustees and/or Institutions run /Conducted by the Trust with a Bank or Banks, to operate such account by any two of the following:

1. President

Secreatary


3. Any of the rest trustees.

(h-1) The TRUST may borrow money or take a loan from the Bank and any finnancial institution. The President and seceratry or secreatry and the principal of the institution will carry out the operation of the loan

(i) To adjust, settle, compromise, compound refer to arbitration, all actions, suits, claims, demands and proceeding regarding the Trust Fund.

(j) To appoint constituted attorneys or agents and to delegate to such attorneys or agents all or any of the powers vested on them under these presents and from time to time remove such attorneys or agents and to appoint

other or others in his or their place

(k) To appoint or make provision for the appointment of any person (including all or any of the trustee and committees or administrators or managing trustees or otherwise) for the purpose of the administration of the Trust in such manner and subject to such rules and regulations as the trustees may prescribe an also to appoint or provide for the appointment of separate Trustees to hold any fund or investment subject to the provisions of this Deed in such manner and subject to suc rules and regulations as the trustees may from time to time think fit.

(I) To make, vary alter or modify schemes, rules and regulations for carrying out the object of the Trust and for the management of the affairs therefor and/ or running any institution in furtherance of the objects of the Trust and

otherwise for giving effect to the object of the Trust .

(m) To start, abolish, discontinue and restart any charity or charitable instirutions for the benefit of general public and to impose any conditions to any subscription donation made by them.

(n) To set apart and/or allocate the whole or a part of the income or the corpus of the Trust fund or part thereof for any of the objects of the Trust.

(o) To join, co-operate or amalgamate this trust with others having considered or allied objects, upon such term and conditions as the trustees may in their discretion think fit, particularly having regard to and in conformity with the object and nature of this Trust.

(p) To give aid by way of donation out of the income or the corpus of the Trust fund or otherwise, to different charitable institutions, societies, organization or trusts in India which may have been established or which may hereafter be established for the like charitable purpose mentioned in these presents or any of them to enable such institution, or carry out such charitable objects.

(q) To settle all accounts and to compromise, compound, abandon, or refer, to arbitration any action or proceedings or disputes, claim, demand or things, as deemed proper for such purpose without being responsible for any

loss occasioned thereby.

(r) To borow moneys either on the security of any property comprised in the trust fund or otherwise for all or any of the purpose of these presents, and it shall be lawful for the Trustees to make such borrowings on payment of such interest and otherwise on such terms and conditions as they may in thir absolute discretion think fit.

(s) To apply to the Government , public bodies, urban, local , municipal , district and other bodies, corporation, companies, or persons for and to accept grant of money and of aid, donations, gifts, subscriptions, and other assistance with a view to promoting the objects of the Trust and to discuss and negotiate with the Government Departments, public and ojther bodies corporations, companies or persons , scheme and other work and matters within the objects of the Trust and to conform to any proper conditions upon which such grant and other payment may be made .

(t) To take over or amalgamate with any other charitable trust, society, association, or institutions with similar objects.

(u) To establish, promote, manage, or organise or maintain or to assist in establishing, promoting, organizing, or maintaining any branch of the Trust or any other Trust or its branch with objects similar to those of this Trust or its and to promote or carry on the affiliantion or amalgamation of such other trust with this Trust.

(v) To take over, acquire, manage, control or any existing institution to the objects of this Trust and on such terms and conditions as may be thought espedient.

(w) To purchase or otherwise acquire and undertake all or any part of the property, assets, liabilities and engagement of any one or more of the trusts , societies, institutions or associations with which this Trust is authorized to amalgamate

(x) To trransfer all or any part of the property, assets, liabilities and engagements of this Trust to any one or more of the trust, societies, institutions or associations with which this Trust is authorized to amalgamate

(y) To transfer and hand over the Trust to any other society corporation institution, Trust or organization on such terms and conctions as the Trustees shall in their absolute discretion think fit and proper to be held by the Society, Corporation, Institution, Trust or organization with the powers, provisions, agreements and declarations, appearing and contained in these presents and subjects to such modifications as may be necessary and consequent to such transfer of the Trust fund. The trustees for the time being of these present shall become discharged from the Trust, thereof relating to Trust Funds so transferred.

(8) The Trustees shall be accountable only, for such moneys, stocks, shares and fund as shall actually come into their hands and a Trustee shall not be answerable or accountable for neglect default, acts or omission or commission of the other Trustees, nor of any banker of other person with whom the trust properties or any securities may bave been deposited or kept.

(9) The Trussess will not be entitled to receive any remuneration, but the Trustees may reimburse themselves all expenses actuall cured by them in connect on with the Trust or their duties reating thereto.

(10) The number of the Trustees shall not be less than three and more than nine. If the numbers of the Trustees shall fall below three the Trustees shall not, except for the purposes of filling any vacancy, act so long as the number is below the minimum

- (11) The managing Trustees for the time being will be at liberty to appoint additional Trustee within the number mentioned above for such period or on such term as to retirement and reappointment as the trustees for the time being consider proper A person shall cease to be a Trustee either (i) if he without leave of absence does not attend three consecutive meeting of the Trustees or for one calendar year, whichever is longer, or (ii) if he is requested to resign by 2/3 th or as near there to as possible of the remaining Trustees.
- (11- A) The general management of the TRUST for the purpose of managing the affairs and properties and carrying out the objecties of the TRUST aforesaid shall be vested in the board of TRUSTEES. The board of TUSTEES shall have one chairman and one Secretary. The first Chairman Shall be Sri Arun Kumar Singh who will hold office of the Chairman for life time and the first Secretary shall be Smt- Maina Kumari Singh who will hold office of Secretary for life time which expression shall wherever the context so admit or requires be deemed to include his /her survivors, heirs and assignees.
- (12) Every Trustee will be at liberty to resign on giving one months notice of his intention to do so
- (13) The Trustees may from time to time frame rules for the conduct and regulations of the meetings of trustees. In the absence of such regula-
- (a) One third of existing Trustees shall form a quorum for a meeting of the Trustees
 - (b) All matters will be decided mutually by the Trustees.
- (c) Resolution passed without any meeting of Trustees but by circulation thereof and evidenced in writing under the hands of two thirds of the trustees shall be as valid and effectual as a Resolution duly passed at a meeting of Trustees.
- (14) The Trustees shall have the power to determine in case of doubt whether any moneys or property shall for the purpose of the carity be considered as capital or income and whether out of income or capital any expenses or outgoing ought to be paid or borne and evey such determination shall be binding and conclusive provided that nothing contained shall be deemed to authorise the Trustees to spend the income by these presents.
- (15) The accounting year of the Trust shall be the financial year is ending on 31 th march Every Year
- (16) The Trust and the Trust funds shall be and irrevocable for all times (17) The office of the Trust shall be situated at Chapra unless changed by the trustees By two - third majority
